NJSFAC Member Benefits

Affinity Credit Union

Members of NJSFAC member squads and their families are eligible to join the [Affinity Federal Credit Union](http://www.affinityfcu.org/home/njsfac.htm) (www.affinityfcu.org/home/njsfac.htm) for various banking, insurance, retirement accounts and other financial advice.

AFLAC Insurance

AFLAC can provide an accident policy and a cancer indemnity policy to our members. Policies are available to members age 18 to 65 but participants are not dropped when they age out; the cancer plan is only available to those that have been cancer free for 10 years and who carry health insurance. Insurance pays your providers but AFLAC pays the member. Payments are independent of other insurance. See their website at www.abnetincnj.com.

Bollinger Insurance

Bollinger offers up to a 15% discount on individual auto insurance policies to NJSFAC members. Bollinger also provides (via AIG) a catastrophic disability insurance policy with a potential maximum benefit of \$1,230,000 to eligible NJSFAC members, all for a \$36 annual premium through Bollinger Insurance. Bollinger also offers two dental insurance plans (via DentaCert Dental) to NJSFAC members and their families. Additional insurance plans are available to Council members. The NJSFAC and [Deborah Heart and Lung Center](http://www.deborah.org) (www.deborah.org) have announced an agreement whereby Deborah Heart and Lung Center will provide certain medical procedures free of charge to NJSFAC member squad personnel.

Dell Computer

NJSFAC member squads and their members can purchase Dell Computers and other related items through the Dell Employee & Affiliates Purchase Program (EPP) at varying discounts up to 12%. You'll need the NJSFAC member ID which is available from your squad delegate or a District officer. The discount is available on phone or Internet orders. EMT Training Fund

EMT-B initial training and the CORE 13 recertification training is free for volunteer members of a volunteer ambulance corps or rescue squad in NJ through the EMT Training Fund. See your Squad Captain or President for signed forms.

FDU - Discounted College Tuition

EMS personnel who enroll at Fairleigh Dickinson University are eligible for a 50% tuition discount. FDU students may also receive immediate credit for 'life experience', CLEP (College Level Examination Program) or transfer credits from other colleges and universities.

Gold Cross Magazine

The official magazine of the NJSFAC is published quarterly and contains a 1.5 CEU article in each edition. The Gold Cross is free to all NJ volunteer EMT-Bs through the EMT Training Fund. To subscribe apply on-line at www.leopub.com.

High Point Insurance

A 5% discount on automobile insurance policies is being offered to our members and their immediate families (living in the same household) by High Point Insurance at no cost to the NJSFAC. High Point also offers homeowner and recreational vehicle policies and has group discounts. Roadside service is an additional available option.

LOSAP (Length of Service Award Program)

Volunteer EMTs can accrue monies into an investment fund specific to each member and based on amount of service rendered to the 'Home' community, to be used after the member's retirement. Municipalities must vote to set up LOSAP accounts for their volunteers.

Scholarships

NJSFAC members are eligible for three scholarship programs:

1. Cadet Scholarship – a \$500 scholarship for cadet and junior members of first aid and rescue squad members of the NJSFAC pursuing a course of study that will lead to a degree from a post-secondary school.
2. Gail Lawrence Memorial Scholarship – a \$1,000 scholarship for those earning advanced degrees in any medical field.
3. Marianne Willis 477 Scholarship – a \$500 scholarship for those pursuing a Paramedic career.

Viridian Energy

Viridian Energy is a NJ BPU approved third party electric supplier. Purchasing your electric power through Viridian allows you, friends, family and neighbors to save 10-20% on your electric bill. The user does not need to sign a long term contract, they can cancel at any time, they will still only pay one bill to their same electric supplier and the best part is that at least 20% of Viridian's energy is from renewable sources (Green Energy). This program is a wonderful fund-raiser for both the NJSFAC and your squad; for every customer your squad signs up that is accepted by Viridian, your squad will receive \$2.00 per month and the Council will receive \$1.00 per month. Volunteer Tuition Credit Program at Community Colleges

Volunteer EMTs and their eligible family members receive up to \$600 of tuition credit for classes taken at New Jersey Community Colleges. Requirements include:

1. The municipality must pass a resolution allowing them to enact the program.
2. The volunteer must agree to serve as a member of the volunteer organization for a minimum of four (4) years.
3. The volunteer must provide one (1) year of active volunteer service prior to each year of college classes.
4. Tuition credit is contingent on space available at the Community College.
